A Legacy Society Grant may be awarded annually from the income of the Las Patronas Endowment Fund. This year's grant funded a refrigerator and computer desks for Casa de Amparo's new Teen Wellness Center, allowing Las Patronas to help provide a safe, healthy, and home-like environment for foster and former foster youth receiving residential services. Since 1978, Casa de Amparo has been working to treat and prevent child abuse and neglect. The agency serves more than 500 Casa Kids per year with integrated programs that promote healing, growth, and healthy relationships. Casa de Amparo serves youth up to age 25 throughout all of San Diego County with locations in Oceanside and San Marcos.

We are so very thankful for the many generous contributions to the Las Patronas Endowment Fund that made this grant possible.


